Unisa update on the legal matter pertaining to Mr Mogaile Mogashoa

On February 18, 2026, the University of South Africa (Unisa) issued a message to stakeholders giving an update on the legal matters pertaining to three specific individuals against whom court judgements have been issued.

These individuals included one Mr Mogaile Mogashoa, against whom a warrant of arrest was issued for being in contempt of a court order prohibiting him from spreading lies about the university, the Principal and Vice-Chancellor Professor Puleng LenkaBula, the Executive Director : Facilities Management Mr Feresane Sibeko, as well as other officials of the university .

The university takes note of the latest update that Mr Mogashoa has since been apprehended and is currently serving a six-month sentence in prison.
